Be it remembered that heretofore on the 28th day of December 1858 came the said Andrew Green in Court here sitting by Wm. G. Poff Solicitor, and filed in Court here the following Bill & Exhibits

By the Honorable Madison Nelson Circuit Judge for the Third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland. The Bill of Complaint of Andrew Green of Frederick County State of Maryland filed in behalf of himself and all other creditors of Christian Smith late of said County and State deceased says may hereafter come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit sheweth, that said Christian Smith by his promissory note dated on the first day of January in the year 1858 payable six months after date was indebted to your Complainant in the sum of sixty six dollars and eighty eight cents with interest from date as will be seen by the said note herewith exhibited marked exhibit No 1 which your Complainant prays together with all other exhibits hereafter produced may be taken as a part of this his bill of Complaint. Your Complainant further states that said note credited with the sum of thirty two dollars and ninety nine cents paid on the seventeenth day of December 1858 by George Smith administrator of said Christian Smith and that the residue of said note is still due, and prays your Complainant further states that the said Christian Smith died intestate on or about the first day of December in the year 1858 and that letters of Administration upon his personal estate have been granted by the orphan Court for Frederick County to George Smith who has fully entered upon the duties of his said office as well appear by a certified Copy of the letters of administration herewith exhibited marked exhibit No 2. Your Complainant further states that the said Christian Smith at the time of his death was seized and possessed in fee of a piece or parcel of a tract of land situate in the County of Frederick State of Maryland - called Ironpeg Hill containing two hundred and eighty two and a half acres of land being the same land heretofore conveyed by your Complainant executor of the last will of said Christian Smith by deed of the 27th of July 1858 which is herewith exhibited marked exhibit No 3.
