

Complainant further states that the said Christian Smith left a widow named Mary Smith and the following children by her at law to whom said lady descended to wit: Marquis R Smith, Mary E Smith, George C Smith, Howard E Smith, Louis M Smith, Dorey J Smith and Clara J Smith all of whom are infants under the age of twenty one year and reside in Frederick County. Complainant further charges that the personal estate of the said Christian Smith is wholly insufficient for the payment of his debts and that a sale of the real estate of said intestate is necessary for the payment of his debts. In the end therefore that the said George C Smith administrator of the goods chattels &c of Christian Smith deceased Marquis R Smith, Mary E Smith, George C Smith, Howard E Smith, Louis M Smith, Dorey J Smith and Clara J Smith may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore stated and that the premises aforesaid or so much thereof as may be necessary may be sold for the payment of the debts of the said Christian Smith and that your Complainant may have such further and other relief as his case may require. May it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainant the writ of Subpoena against the said George C Smith administrator of the goods chattels &c of Christian Smith deceased Marquis R Smith, George C Smith, Howard E Smith, Louis M Smith, Dorey J Smith and Clara J Smith of Frederick County commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the purposes and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and your Complainant as in duty bound &c
