This Indenture made the fiveth day of March 1856 between Lewis
& Kemp Executors of Col. Lewis Kemp dec'd of Frederick County
State of Maryland of the one part, and Christian Smith of said
County & State of the other part. Whereas by the last will &
testament of the said Lewis Kemp dec'd bearing date on the
26th of July 1834 & duly admitted to probate the said Lewis Kemp
gave & bequeathed & devised all his estate & property real & personal
& conveyed to the said Lewis & Kemp & directed said Lewis &
Kemp as executors to sell the same as well appear by reference
to said will duly recorded in the office of the Register of
Wills of Frederick County in Liber 5, folio 579 &c and
whereas by an order passed by the Orphans Court of Frederick
County bearing date the 18th of January 1855 the said Lewis
& Kemp executor was authorized & empowered to sell the real
estate so as aforesaid devised at private sale and whereas
the said Lewis & Kemp in pursuance of the power so as
aforesaid vested in him by said last will & by said order of the
Orphans Court did on the twenty fourth of January 1856 sell
at private sale to the said Christian Smith the property here
inafter described & conveyed for the sum of Current money and
eight hundred & fifty dollars which said sale has been duly
proved by said Orphans Court and whereas the said
Christian Smith hath fully paid & satisfied to the said
Lewis & Kemp as executor aforesaid said full amount
of purchase money & by this Indenture Witnesseth that for
the consideration of the purchase & also of one dollar current
money by the said Christian Smith to the said Lewis & Kemp
my hand paid at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Lewis &
Kemp hath bargained & sold aliened & conveyed by these
presents doth here grant bargain & sell sign, seal, deliver
confirm & confirm unto the said Christian Smith his heirs &
assigns all the following piece or parcel of land to Wit -
Beginning at a stone planted in the borders of Ga. fence
Hedge Road being at the end of twenty seven & forty five
