

personal estate of said deceased have been granted by the Orphans Court of said County to a certain Isaiah Deulbis of said County as will appear by exemplification of said letters herewith filed as a part of the Bill & marked Exhibit D that said deceased at the time of his death was seized and possessed of said real estate which is mentioned and described in an unrecorded deed from David Engel of said County to said James Carter bearing date the 29th day of December A.D. 1852 that Engel has been paid the whole of the purchase money for said real estate and that said Engel has no interest whatever in and to said real estate which said unrecorded deed is herewith filed as a part of the Bill and marked Exhibit E. and your orators further show that said administrator in virtue of said letters of administration has possessed himself of all the personal estate left by said deceased at the time of his death and your orators are informed and charge that the said personal estate is insufficient to pay the just debts of said deceased. and your orators are advised that as the personal estate of said James Carter deceased in the hands of his administrator is insufficient for the payment of all his just debts your orators and his other creditors kept unsatisfied are entitled to have their claims paid out of the real estate of the said deceased. So the end therefore that the defendants hereinafter named may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore charged as fully and particularly as if they were themselves interested and that the real estate of the said deceased or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose aforesaid may be sold for the payment of the claims of your orators and of the other unsatisfied claims of the creditors of said deceased and that your orators may have such other and further relief in the premises as Equity and good Conscience may require. May it please your Honor to grant unto your orators the writ of subpoena against the said Catharine Carter John Carter & Catharine his wife Benjamin L Carter William Carter George Deucas & Ann his wife Mary L Carter Charles Key & Samuel his wife Thomas H Carter and David Engel of said County and to appear in this Court at a certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and as in Equity &c
