No 2799 In the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity
 Arbans from 1859

The Court having read & considered the foregoing petition & exhibits referred to. It is thereupon the 28th day of March in the year 1859 by one Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity and by the authority of the said Court adjudged ordered & decreed that John W. Charlton & Dwight Nelson be & they are hereby appointed trustees to take charge of & invest Susan Ransburg's proportion being one half of the net proceeds of the sale of the real estate reported in the above case & to carry out the trust created by the will of said Susan Ransburg relative thereto & the course & manner of their proceedings shall be as follows they shall first file with the Clerk of this Court a bond to be executed by themselves with security to be approved by this Court or the Clerk thereof payable to the State of Maryland in the penal sum of fifteen thousand dollars & conditioned for the faithful discharge of the trust proposed in them by the Decree or which may be imposed in them by any future decree or order in the premises & that upon filing said bond said Susan Ransburg's proportion being one half of the net proceeds of said sales as hereinafore reported shall be audited to said trustees and on the satisfaction of said audit & the payment of said money to them the said trustee shall invest said funds in a good & safe manner & pay the interest accruing thereon to the Pipe Creek Benevolent Society during the life of Stephen Ransburg & on the death of said Stephen Ransburg they shall bring said funds into this Court for distribution among the parties entitled thereto under the last will and testament and codicil of said Susan Ransburg and it is further ordered that said trustee shall make an annual report of their proceedings as such trustee to this Court
