This Indenture made this fifth day of April in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty five
 between William Wolf and Catharine Wolf his wife of
 Hardridge County State of Maryland of the one part
 and Thomas Cader of the said County & State of the other
 part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum
 of seven hundred dollars current money by the said
 Thomas Cader to them in hand paid at & before the
 sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof
 they do hereby acknowledge they the said William &
 Catharine Wolf have bargained & sold alien & conveyed
 and by these presents do give grant bargain & sell alien
 release convey & confirm unto the said Thomas Cader
 his heirs and assigns all that lot of land situate lying
 & being near the town of Hardridge immediately on the
 road leading from the said town to the mill formerly
 owned by Col. Baker Johnson now in the occupancy of
 Basil Shriver being the same lot of land which was
 conveyed to the said Catharine Wolf by Col. Baker
 Johnson on the first day of March 1804 Beginning
 for the said lot at a corner stone standing
 at the east end of the ... of land and
 running thence North 28 degrees East fourteen perches to a stone
 in ... Road then north the road North fifty nine and
 one half degrees East forty nine perches to a marked post
 then South and one half degree West 30 perches and one half to
 the beginning containing six acres three Rods and nine
 perches together with all & singular the improvements
 privileges ways water ways Ponds & appurtenances right
 members and advantages thereto belonging or in anywise
 appertaining and all the estate right title & interest in &
 property therein and to have & to enjoy the same with
 full & quiet enjoyment of them the said William & the said Catharine Wolf
