 sworn to the 1st Interrogatory I do know all the parties
 Complainant and defendant to the 2nd Interrogatory I
 do know Thomas Cade he died about ten years ago
 to the 3rd Interrogatory I look at the papers here shown me
 red exhibits A B C D & E Thomas Cade died seized of the
 Real Estate therein described with the exception of so much
 of the Real Estate described in Exhibit G as said Thomas
 Cade & wife conveyed to her issue to the 4th Interrogatory
 He did leave a widow named Margaret Cade she is still
 living as his widow & is one of the Defendants in this suit
 to the 5th Interrogatory I look at the papers now shown me
 marked Exhibit G Augustus & Cady Jdct. Cade
 & Catharine Cade & Isabella etc. but the wife of
 Charles & C the Complainant in this case are the same
 parties named in said exhibit G to the 6th Interrogatory
 Susanna Keller the wife of Charles Keller who is named in
 said last will & testament of Thomas Cade as a child and
 devisee is dead she died about 12 years ago & before her
 fathers death none of her children are living they died young
 without issue to the 7th & 8th Interrogatory I do know
 named in said will of Thomas Cade as a child and
 devisee is dead he died about 15 years ago at the age
 of 12 or 14 years he was never married & died with issue
 to the 8th Interrogatory The Margaret Isabella Cade named
 in said will is the same person in the bill of Complaint
 in this case as the wife of Mr John Hefley she is dead
 and died about 12 or 14 months ago leaving but one child
 named Isabella who is an infant residing in the Territory
 to the 9th Interrogatory all the parties to this Cause
 are adults but Margaret Isabella Hefley is now a wife
 to the 10th Interrogatory It would be to the advantage of all
 the parties interested infant as well as adults that the Real
 Estate of which Thomas Cade died seized should be sold & the
 proceeds distributed among them to the 11th Interrogatory
 The said Real Estate is not capable of a partition
 division amongst the parties to this suit because it would
 require the land to be cut up into too small parcels and the
 quantity of fencing that would then be needed would be an
 expensive & the land thus divided would not be as profitable
 as the proceeds of the sale judicially directed the Jdct
 for the Complainant filed with me & herewith returned
 the papers marked exhibits A B C D E F & G H I & J
 no further evidence I closed the said Commission & herewith
 sworn the same closed under my hand & seal this 2nd day of
