

The Bill of Complaint of David Bar, John H Bar, William Bar, & Eliza A Bar, his wife all of Frederick County by her, My Mother Lett Bar late of said County deceased, His life in testate some time in the month of June in the year 1758 leaving the said David Bar, John H Bar, & Eliza A Bar, his children and Eliza Ann Bar, Sarah & Bar, Catharine & Bar, John H Bar, Sarah & Bar, William & Bar, & Jacob & Bar, his grand children his only heirs at law that said grand children are the children & only heirs of a deceased Don Jacob Bar who died in the month of January in the year 1705 that said grand children all reside in Augusta County State of Virginia and are all infants under age except the said Eliza Ann Bar who is above the age of 21 years and are all residents of the State that said Jacob Bar did seized and possessed in fee of a certain piece or parcel of land lying in said Frederick County containing about one hundred and twenty seven acres more or less and which is mentioned and described in a deed from David Bar to said Bar as a certified copy of which deed is to wit filed in the exhibit of which are copies & seal of the same to be taken and considered as a part of the said Bill of Complaint and your copies & seal of the same to be taken and the said Real Estate is not susceptible of partition amongst the aforesaid parties and that it will be given to the interest and advantage of all the parties entitled the adults and infants as well as the voters and electors that said Real Estate be sold and the proceeds divided amongst the parties entitled and that your voters and electors hereby expressly make all and every part of said and election given by the act of the 11th of the year 1720 Chapter 191 But nevertheless that your voters & electors are made by except to the aid of your Honorable Court to the said Eliza Ann Bar, David Bar, Catharine & Bar, John H Bar, Sarah & Bar, William & Bar, and Jacob & Bar, and that a decree may be passed for the sale of said Real Estate in the discretion of this Honorable Court and the distribution of the proceeds amongst the parties entitled according to the said act & election and that your voters & electors may have such other and further relief as the case in law and good conscience may require in that behalf your Honorable Court grant unto your voters & electors an order of judicial process to the said Eliza Ann Bar, David Bar, Catharine & Bar, John H Bar, Sarah & Bar, William & Bar, and Jacob & Bar, to appear and assist of this bill and to answer to the same in person or by their counsel or by their agent and to do and suffer all things in that behalf required to be done and to pay a fine and costs of the
