Bar & others as Defendants being No 2795 on the Equity docket of said Court & to report back before the standing Commission duly qualified and approved to take the following depositions at my law office in Frederick on Thursday the 13th day of January 1859 I do not a sitting of lawful being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with me by the Complainants Solicitor and pursuant returned depositions to the Defendant & return the Complainant to return the depositions to the said Judge & return on a depositions the rest I believe are means to the said Real Estate conveyed in this case & in the paper filed as Exhibit A, to the 4th Decr the said Real Estate is not susceptible of advantageous division to the 5th Decr it would be to the interest and advantage of all parties interested infants as well as adults that said Real Estate should be sold and the proceeds of sale distributed to the 6th Decr & return nothing further to the Bar filed last Spring. You being sworn further evidence I closed the said Commission and herewith return the same closed under my hand and seal this 13th day of January 1859
