

Dollars by his single bill of that date payable one year
 after date with interest from date as will more fully
 appear from said single bill herewith filed marked exhibit
 N^o 1 which with all other exhibits herewith filed marked
 your orator prays may be taken and considered as parts of
 this bill of Complaint and that on the same day the said
 Michael Hoke executed & delivered to the said Jacob Bott &
 Peter Bott a Deed of Mortgage upon several tracts or
 parcels of land containing together two hundred and
 forty five acres more or less and which said lands are
 particularly described in said Deed of Mortgage and
 which are situate in said Frederick County and State of
 Maryland to secure the payment of said sum of money and
 interest all which will more fully appear by reference being
 had to said deed of mortgage herewith filed marked exhibit
 N^o 2 and which said Deed of Mortgage was duly recorded
 amongst the Land Records of Frederick County on the 12th
 day of April in the said year 1852, Your orator further to your
 Honor that on the 28th day of March in the year 1853 the
 said Michael Hoke executed & delivered to the said Jacob
 Bott & Peter Bott his promissory note payable ninety days
 after date with interest for the sum of eight hundred and
 seven dollars being for the whole balance of interest due to
 that date on the said mortgage debt as will appear from
 said promissory note herewith filed marked exhibit N^o 3
 Your orator further shews to your Honor that on the 26th day
 of March in the year 1857 the said mortgage debt and interest
 remaining unpaid except such portion of interest as had
 been paid as aforesaid the said Jacob Bott and Peter
 Bott for value received assigned and transferred to your
 orator the said single bill and the said deed of mortgage
 and the said promissory note as will appear by the
 assignments in writing respectively produced hereon and
 that the said Michael Hoke has had due notice of said
 assignments and that the said mortgage debt and interest
 is due and payable to your orator. And your orator
 further shews to your Honor that on the 1st day of April
 in the year 1857 the said Michael Hoke paid to
 your orator the sum of five hundred dollars in amount
 of said mortgage debt and interest and that on
 the same day the said Jacob Bott paid to your orator
 five hundred dollars also in part of said mortgage
 debt which has been guaranteed by said Jacob Bott and
 Peter Bott and your orator states that there is due from
 the said Michael Hoke to your orator the said sum of
 four thousand dollars with interest from the 28th day
 of March 1853 and also the said said sum of eight
 hundred and seven dollars with interest from said
 28th day of March 1853 except the payment thereon of
 five hundred dollars by said Hoke on the said 1st day
