 Bill of Complaint of George Smith in the Circuit Court
 for Frederick County sitting in County exhibited

 Bott & Peter Bott his single bill payable one year after
 date for the sum of Four thousand dollars and interest
 & that on the same day he executed & delivered to them
 his deed of mortgage in said Bill mentioned and
 that on the 28th day of March 1852 he also executed &
 delivered to them his promissory for the sum of Eight
 hundred and seven dollars payable ninety days after
 date with interest which was for the balance of
 interest on said mortgage debt due to that day and that
 on the 26th day of March in the year 1857 the said single
 bill deed of mortgage and promissory note were duly
 assigned by the said Jacob Bott & Peter Bott to the
 Complainant as alleged in said Bill and that on the
 first day of April in the year 1857 this Respondent paid
 to the Complainant the sum of Five hundred dollars
 & that on the same day the said Jacob Bott paid to said
