 date each on the 1st day of November 1834 & payable respectively
 at one ten & twenty days after the date thereof for the several
 sums of eighty twenty & sixty five \$000 dollars on one of which
 notes divers payments have been made and will more fully
 and at large appear by reference to copies of the said
 notes herewith exhibited marked exhibit A which together
 with all other exhibits herewith filed your orators respectfully
 pray may be taken and considered as a part of this their bill
 of Complaint, and your orators further shew that the said
 Catharine B. Watts deceased was likewise in her lifetime
 and at the time of her death indebted unto your orator
 Thomas B. Cwing, in the sum of thirty three dollars
 and twenty five cents on open account for medical
 services rendered and medicines furnished the said deceased
 by the said Thomas B. Cwing as physician and in re-
 spectfully and at large appear by reference to a copy of the
 said account herewith exhibited marked exhibit B
 and your orators further charge that the said Catharine
 B. Watts being indebted as aforesaid unto your orators
 and also unto divers other persons departed this life about
 18 months ago intestate leaving no personal property or
