 person on the estate of the said deceased. But your orators
 further charge that the said Catharine B. Watts did seized
 and possessed of valuable Real Estate situated in Frederick
 County aforesaid as will more fully and at large appear
 reference being had to a duly authenticated copy of the
 deed or title paper of the said Catharine B. Watts for the said
 property herewith exhibited and marked Exhibit C and your
 orators further shew that the said Catharine B. Watts at the
 time of her decease left the following children and heirs at
 law who are still living to wit Elizabeth C. Watts formally
 now Elizabeth C. Keith wife of George W. Keith of Baltimore
 County who is of full age James Monroe Watts who is of full
 age and a non resident of this State his residence being
 unknown to your orators John Quincy Watts George Harrison
 Watts Susan Rebecca Watts William Andrew Watts Laura
 Jane Watts and Winfield Scott Watts all residents of Baltimore
 County aforesaid and infants under the age of twenty one years
 and your orators are advised that as the said deceased left
 no personal estate whatever or if any then only such as was
 merely nominal and wholly insufficient to discharge any of the
 debts aforesaid and as your orators and other Creditors are
 altogether unsatisfied they are entitled to have their Claims
 paid out of the Real Estate of the said deceased as aforesaid
 to the end therefore that the defendant hereinafter named may
 answer the several matters and things hereinbefore charged as
 fully and particular as if they were themselves interrogated and
 that the Real Estate of the said deceased or so much thereof as
 may be necessary for the purpose may be sold for payment of
 the claims of your orators and of the other unsatisfied creditors
 of the said deceased, and that your orators may have all such
 for their and other relief as the nature of their Case may require
 may it please your Honor to grant unto your orators an order
 of publication giving notice to the said James Monroe Watts
 who is a non resident as before stated of the substance and
 object of this Bill and warning him to appear in this Court
 at a certain day or by Solicitor or before a certain day to answer
 the premises and shew Cause if any he has why a decree ought
 not to pass as prayed and also a writ of subpoena against the
 said Elizabeth C. Keith George W. Keith John Quincy Watts George
 Harrison Watts Susan Rebecca Watts William Andrew Watts
 Laura Jane Watts and Winfield Scott Watts of Baltimore
 County Commanding them to appear in this Court at some
 day certain to be therein named to answer the premises and
 abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein
 and to in due bound &c.
