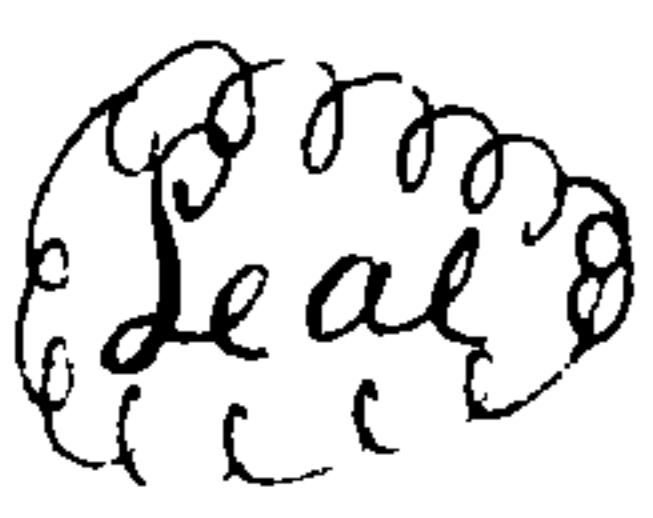

At the request of Catharine Watts the following Deed was recorded 5th Decr 1848 -

This Indenture made this 30th day of June in the year of our Lord 1848 between Susannah Watts of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the one part and Catharine Watts the wife of John Watts of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part - Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars Current money by the said Catharine Watts to the said Susannah Watts in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which she doth hereby acknowledge that she the said Susannah Watts hath been fully paid and satisfied for the same and the said Susannah Watts hath bargained and sold aliened and reffered and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien reffered release convey and confirm unto the said Catharine Watts her heirs and assigns all of that part of a tract of land called Middle Plantation lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid and contained within the following meter bounds courses and distances to wit. Beginning for the same at a binder white oak the beginning of Charles Street part of Middle Plantation and running thence 1 North 2 1/2 degrees West by a stone planted at the end of the third level of said Street part the distance of 116 perches to a stake near a marked black Oak sapple; 2 North 75 1/2 degs East 48 ps to a stake at the
