This Indenture made this 3^d day of June 1855 between -
Asbury Chambers and Melly Chambers his wife (Colored persons) of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part -
and Brooke Baker and George W. Shank of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Asbury Chambers & Melly Chambers his wife for & in consideration of the sum of Seventy eight dollars Current money of the State of Maryland to them in hand paid by the said Brooke Baker & George W. Shank at & before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Asbury Chambers & Melly Chambers his wife doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained & sold released and conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien release conveyed and confirmed unto the said Brooke Baker & George W. Shank their heirs and assigns forever all that lot of land N^o 2 - Beginning at B at a stone planted in the new road leading from Woodsons to Pichelliers Mills and running thence N 27 1/2^o W 7 1/2^o to the beginning of Lot N^o 1 originally laid for Jacob Armstrong (Col^d man) & with the given line of said lot runned S 67^o W 37 1/2^o to a stone planted S 19^o E 66 1/2^o to a stone planted then with a straight line to the beginning containing one acre 2 rods & 2 perches of land together with
