This Deed made the tenth day of January in the year 1859 by David  
 O Baker of Huedenich County in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth  
 that in Consideration of twelve hundred dollars the said David  
 O Baker doth grant unto John B. Stimme of the aforesaid County  
 and State all the right title and interest in and to his the said  
 David O Baker proportional share of the estate of Brook Baker  
 a former resident of County and State aforesaid now deceased  
 and having died intestate the said Conveyance of interest  
 extending to all the Real and personal property to which  
 the said David O Baker is entitled as an heir in law of  
 the said Brook Baker deceased.
