 sealed with our seals and dated this second day of June
 1840. Whereas the said David Wolfe is on this day appointed
 by John Hanitt, Justice for the benefit of the creditors of Isaac
 Draper an applicant for the insolvent law of 1805 and its
 several supplements, Now the Condition of the above obligation
 is such that if the above bound David Wolfe is a Justice
 of the said Isaac Draper do and shall will and truly -
 perform the several duties required of him by the act of Assembly
 of this State entitled, An act for the relief of sundry insolvent
 Debtors passed at November session 1805 and the several supple -
 ments thereto then this obligation to be void else to remain
 in full force and virtue in Law
