At the request of Daniel Moam the following Deed is recorded February 11th 1850
This Indenture made this 27th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Adam Custard late Sheriff of Frederick County in the state of Maryland of the one part and Daniel Moam of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Whereas on the 22^d day of June 1847 a Certain writ of the State of Maryland of fieri facias did issue forth out of Frederick County and to the Sheriff of said County directed reciting that whereas at a County Court begun and held at the Court house in Frederick town in and for said County on the 4th Monday of February 1843 a certain Daniel Moam claim of Daniel Bleckentoff by Judgment of the same Court recovered against a certain Andrew Draper as well the sum of six hundred and ten dollars say six hundred and ten dollars as well the sum of one thousand dollars currency for his damages which he had sustained as well by reason of the detention of that debt as for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that behalf laid out and expended Whereof the said Andrew is Comel as it appears of record and
