

Whereas also in the said Court on the 4th Monday of February 1825 it was Considered that the said Daniel Main adm^r of Daniel Blickenstaff should have his execution against the said Andrew Draper for as well the debt damages Costs and Charges aforesaid as also for the sum of five dollars 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cents Current which to the said Daniel Main as aforesaid in the said Court was adjudged for his Costs and Charges which he had sustained by delay of the execution aforesaid. Whereof the said Andrew Draper is Committed as it appears of Record therefore you are hereby Commanded that of the goods and Chattle lands and Tenements of the said Andrew Draper being in your bailiwick you Cause to be made the debt damages Cost and Charges aforesaid and have you those Sums before the Judges of the next County Court to be held at the Court House in Frederick Town in and for said County on the 4th Monday of October next to render unto the said Daniel Main adm^r of Daniel Blickenstaff the debt damage Costs and Charges aforesaid and also said Court-Costs to the hands of the said Sheriff and in pursuance of the Command therein contained the said Sheriff laid the same upon all the all the right title of the said Andrew Draper of in and to all that part of a tract of land called The Range about the memorable Nobs situated lying & being in the County and State aforesaid containing 93 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of land more or less the interest aforesaid being two sevenths part thereof and whereas after due notice being given of the same the said Sheriff did on the seventh day of February 1825 expose all the said interest or two sevenths part of said land to public Sale to the highest bidder and thereat the venditor named Daniel Main became the highest bidder and purchaser of the same at and for the sum of six dollars and twenty five cents and hath since paid the said purchase money to the said Adam Custard late Sheriff and is now desirous of obtaining a title to the same in consequence thereof Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Adam Custard late Sheriff as aforesaid for and in Consideration of the premises aforesaid and the further sum of five dollars Current money to him in hand paid by the said Daniel Main at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien release & confirm unto the said Daniel Main his heirs and assigns all the said interest or two sevenths part of said Andrew Draper of in and to the said land and premises which is fully described in a deed of Conveyance from John Wiseman & to Andrew Draper & others by deed bearing date the 18th day of May 1824 and recorded in Liber 2 of M² folio 900c one of the land records of Frederick County.
