 the said Daniel Leatherman being then and there the highest
 bidder became the purchaser thereof for the price or sum of forty
 dollars, and whereas the said sale was duly reported to and
 ratified by the Honorable County Court in pursuance of the
 provisions of the act of Assembly in such Case made and
 provided. Now this Certificate Witnesseth that in pursuance
 of the provisions and for and in consideration of the payment
 of the sum of forty dollars to him the said Jacob Young of D
 Constable as aforesaid in hand paid by said Daniel Leatherman
 at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged he the said Jacob Young of D Constable
 as aforesaid hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents
 doth fully & effectually as he lawfully may or can bargain
 and sell alien give release and confirm unto the
 said Daniel Leatherman all the estate right title and interest
 property claim and demand at law and in Equity of the said
 William Draper & in and to the said land and premises with
 the appurtenances which was liable to be sold under the said
 writs and which he the said Jacob Young of D Constable as aforesaid
 might or could lawfully sell by force of said writs and which
 he the said Jacob Young of D Constable as aforesaid hath
 the said Daniel Leatherman his heirs and assigns to his and their
