Bidmon and Washington A. Bidmon are Defendants the above bound Frederick White has been appointed Trustee to make Sale of Certain Real Estate in the proceedings in said Cause mentioned. Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Frederick White do and shall well and faithfully perform the Trust reposed in him by said decree or that may be reposed in him by any future order or decree in the premises then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in Law
