The Petition of John House of Frederick County one of the Children and devisees of William House late of Frederick County deceased respectfully sheweth unto your honor that William House late of Frederick County on the eighth day of October 1818 in due form of Law made and executed his testament and last will and some time about the first of May 1819 departed this life without having revoked the same a true and certified copy of said Will is here exhibited marked exhibit A. which together with all other exhibits your petitioner prays may be made a part of this Petition as if here inserted in words and figures your petitioner further states that the said Testator amongst other things devised and bequeathed as follows "I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal to be disposed of by my Executors hereafter named to the best advantage appearing the mode to them to make the most of it and after all the legacies are paid all Court Charges Law Suits that have commenced or may be brought for the recovery of my property or any part thereof fully satisfied and my Executors fully compensated for all their trouble and expence the residue to be equally divided between my two Children John House your Petitioner and Elizabeth Wife of Thomas Miles Shaw and share alike your Honor is further informed that the said William House the testator constituted and appointed John Frazer and Thomas Marlow to be Executors of said Will as fully appears by said last will and testament your petitioner states further that the said John Frazer and Thomas Marlow did
