At the request of Base Norris the following Deed is recorded February 16th 1828.
 My Indenture made this 16th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between John Norris of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Base Norris of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Norris for and in Consideration of the sum of two thousand eight hundred dollars Current money to him in hand before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Norris doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm unto him the said Base Norris his heirs and assigns forever all his the said John Norris right title interest claim & demand of in and to his undivided interest in the following tracts or parcels of land to wit all that part of a tract of land called Ashers Field containing 131 acres and one quarter of an acre of land in the same name as well also all that part of a tract or parcel of land called Woods Lot be the number of acres more or less and the same property heretofore conveyed to John & Norris by the heirs of a certain John Sturgeson by four several deeds regularly recorded in the County aforesaid in Liber N. R. N. 45 folio 633c & N. 1 folio 192c & N. 2 folio 581c & N. 5 folio 753c both of the above tracts or parcels of land lying and being in Frederick County and State aforesaid the first part of a tract of land called Ashers Field conveyed to the said John & Norris father of the said John Norris by a certain Catharine Asher by deed dated the 6th day of January 1795 and regularly recorded in the County aforesaid in Liber N. R. N. 13 folio 290c one eleventh part of the within -
