This Indenture made the 14th day of February in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between Otho Norris of
Montgomery County and State of Maryland of the one part and
Lott Norris John Norris and Lloyd Norris of Frederick County and
State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Otho Norris
for and in consideration of the sum of \$1480. Cur. money of the United
States to him in hand paid by the said Lott Norris John Norris
and Lloyd Norris before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained
and sold aliened infeoffed conveyed and confirmed and by these
presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien release infeoff
and confirm unto them the said Lott Norris John Norris and Lloyd
Norris all his the said Otho Norris' right title interest claim and demand
of in and to his undivided interest in the following tracts or parts
of tracts of land to wit all that part of a tract of land called
Waters Archbold containing one hundred and thirty one acres and
one quarter of an acre of land more or less also all that part of a
tract of land called "Woody Lot" to the number of one acre more or
less and the same property heretofore conveyed to John S. Norris by the
heirs of a certain John Sturgeson, by four several deeds regularly
executed and recorded in the County aforesaid recorded in Liber M. R.
N^o 25 folio 633 &c & B N^o 1 folio 19 & L. D. N^o 2 folio 581 &c & L. D. N^o 5 folio
73 &c both of the above tracts or parcels of land lying and being in
Frederick County and State aforesaid the first part of a tract of
land called Waters Archbold conveyed to the said John S. Norris
father of the said Otho Norris by a certain Catharine Wetherby deed
dated the 16th day of January 1795 and regularly recorded in the
County aforesaid Liber M. R. N^o 13 folio 29 &c the within described
property was conveyed to the said Otho Norris & other heirs and
representatives of a certain John S. Norris by Basil Norris also one of the
