At the request of Lott Norris the following Deed is
 recorded October 28th 1860

My Indenture made this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between Loya Norris of
 Frederick's County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Lott Norris
 of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. It is remembered that the
 said Loya Norris for and in consideration of the sum of \$117,700
 present money of the United States in hand paid by the said Lott
 Norris before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 he the said Loya Norris doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bar-
 gained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Lott
 Norris and his heirs and assigns all and singular the right title
 interest property claim and demand of him the said Loya Norris of
 and to all his undivided interest in all that tract or parcel of land
 lying and being in the County aforesaid called Usher's freehold containing
 one hundred and thirty one acres and one quarter of an acre of land
 more or less being the same tract or parcel of land which was conveyed
 to John P. Norris by a certain Catherina Usher by deed dated on or
 about the 16th day of January 1795 and recorded in Liber N. R. N. 13
 folios 290 &c one of the Land records of Frederick's County aforesaid together
 with all and singular the buildings improvements hereditaments & appurtenances
