Which is then indorsed by Maryland Frederick's County to wit Be it remembered that on the day the seventh of April in the year 1830 personally appears Base Norns the grantor named in the foregoing deed or instrument of writing and he acknowledges the same to be his act and deed and the part of a tract of land and premises therein mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the rights members and appurtenances to be the right title and estate of Lott Norns the grantor also therein named and his heirs and assigns forever according to the true intent and meaning thereof and the acts of Assembly in such Cases made and provided, at the same time also appears Jane Norns wife of the said Base Norns and she acknowledges the foregoing deed or instrument of writing to be her act and deed for the purposes therein expressed and set forth according to the true intent and meaning of the same and the acts of Assembly in such Case made and provided, and the said Jane Norns being by us privately examined apart from and out of the hearing of her said husband she acknowledges and declares that she doth make her acknowledgment of the same willingly and freely & without being induced thereto by fear threats of or ill usage by her said husband or fear of his displeasure acknowledged before us the subscribers two Justices of the peace in and for said County
