At the request of Lott Morris the following Deed
 is Recorded June 20th 1844

This Indenture made this 20th day of June in the year of our Lord
 1844 between Lydia Morris of Frederick County in the State of Maryland
 of the one part and Lott Morris of the County and State
 aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Lydia Morris for and
 in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty three dollars
 current money of the United States to her in hand paid by the said
 Lott Morris before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof she the said Lydia Morris does hereby acknowledge has granted
 bargained sold aliened infeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents
 does grant bargain sell alien infeoff and Confirm unto the said Lott
 Morris his heirs and assigns all of any undivided one eleventh part of
 one hundred and twenty four and a half acres and 11 ps of land it
 being that part of a tract of land called Lichen Tract and lying in the
 County aforesaid wherein the said Lott Morris now resides together with all
 and singular the buildings improvements hereditaments and appurtenances
 whatsoever thereto belonging or in any way appertaining and the reversions
 and remainders unto issue and profits thereof and all the estate right title
 and interest whatsoever of her the said Lydia Morris both at Law and
 Equity of in to and out of the said parcel of land and premises hereby
 bargained and sold or meantly mentioyned or intended hereby to be and
 every or any part or parcel thereof to have and to hold the said parcel
