Deed was recorded September 7th 1858 -

The Indenture made this 12th day of May in the year of Our Lord 1855 between John Eggenbrode of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and John Ross Netheron of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of ninety dollars current money by the said John Ross Netheron to the said John Eggenbrode in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which he doth hereby acknowledge himself to be lawfully satisfied and paid the said John Eggenbrode hath bargained & sold aliened and conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien release convey and confirm unto the said John Ross Netheron his heirs and assigns
