

This Indenture made this 25th day of February in the year of
 our Lord 1850 between John Witheron of Frederick County in the
 State of Maryland first named hereinafter mentioned of the one
 part and John Rofs Witheron of the said County and State
 of the other part, Whereas by a decree of Frederick County Court
 sitting as a Court of Equity bearing date of November term in the
