

John Wetheron and John A. Martin Defendants who are adults
 to the 2^d Interrogatory, I look at the paper now shown, one and
 marked as Exhibit N^o 1 in this Cause I know the handwriting
 of John Rof Wetheron and the Signature to the said Exhibit
 N^o 1 is in the hand writing of the said John Rof Wetheron
 who is the same person as John R F Wetheron, whose name is subscribed
 to the said Exhibit The said paper was first made payable
 to me (the Witness) and by me all ^{my} right and interest in said
 paper was transferred to Thomas S Wetheron to whom the said
 paper is now payable and who is the holder and owner of said
 paper. To the 3^d Interrogatory I know John Rof Wetheron he is
 dead he died in April 1858 and left a widow & five children
 to wit John W. Wetheron, Elizabeth Wetheron, John Rof Wetheron,
 Thomas S. Wetheron and William Wetheron all of whom are
 infants or minors, and reside in Frederick County. To the 4th
 Interrogatory I know left real estate and it is all situated in Frederick
 County and is correctly described in Exhibits from N^o 1 to 5 which
 said Exhibits are filed as evidence in this Cause, the land described
 in Exhibit N^o 6 was sold by John Rof Wetheron to the 5th Interrogatory
 John Rof Wetheron died intestate and myself (the Witness) and John
 A. Martin were the administrators on his estate I know the condition
 of the personal estate there are adults unpaid one of the debts
 unpaid is the note filed as Exhibit N^o 7 and another of about the
 sum of one thousand dollars due Sarah A. Wetheron the personal
 estate will by no means pay these debts. There being no further
 testimony and no further time being being agreed for the production
 of witnesses I have closed this Commission and herewith return the
 same together with Exhibits N^o from 1 to 9 filed in this Cause
