 part of the her Bill of Complaint. Your Complainant further
 states that on the first day of April then next ensuing the
 said Contract, the said Elizabeth Coblenz paid the said
 sum of three hundred and thirty seven dollars and fifty cts part
 payment of the said purchase money and on said first of
 April 1857 executed her two Single Bills under hand and
 Seal each for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars -
 value of said purchase money, one payable twelve months
 after date the other payable two years after date both bearing
 interest from date all of which may more fully appear by
 reference to the said single bills herewith exhibited marked
 Exhibit N^o 2 and Exhibit N^o 3, your Complainant charges
 that said notes were given for the purchase money of said
 House and Lot and are liens thereon and that Elizabeth
 Coblenz on the 17th day of November 1858 paid thirty dollars
 on the note marked Exhibit N^o 2 which is credited thereon
 and on the third of April 1859 paid thirty dollars as interest
 and twenty five dollars as principal on the note marked -
 Exhibit N^o 3 which is credited thereon and that no other part
 of said notes for purchase money has been paid and that the
 balance of the money due on said single bills still remain
 due and unpaid although due and owing for some time
 past. Your Complainant further states that on the 24th day
 of September in the year 1858 the said Elizabeth Coblenz
 by indemnify and save harmless Samuel Bowles as
 her security to Thomas Shafer in a note therein recited -
 executed a mortgage to said Samuel Bowles conveying
 to him the the said house and Lot heretofore sold by your
 Complainant to the said Elizabeth Coblenz as will more fully
 appear by a certified Copy of the said Mortgage herewith
 exhibited marked Exhibit N^o 4 your Complainant further
 states that afterwards to wit on the 22^d day of January in the
 year 1859 the said Samuel Bowles by deed conveyed all his
 Estate real personal mixed and Choses in action to Stephen
 B Bowles upon the trusts therein stated as will appear by a
 Certified Copy of the said deed herewith exhibited marked
 Exhibit N^o 5 Your Complainant further states that said
 Samuel Bowles died intestate in the year 1859 wholly and
 without any estate whatever and that no letters of
 administration have been taken out there being no estate
 to administer your Complainant further states that the
 said Samuel Bowles has paid the said claim to said
 Thomas Shafer and that said Thomas Shafer has recovered
 Judgment on said claim as will appear by a copy of
 said Judgment marked Exhibit N^o 6 which Judgment remains
 unpaid by said Elizabeth Coblenz or the said Samuel Bowles
