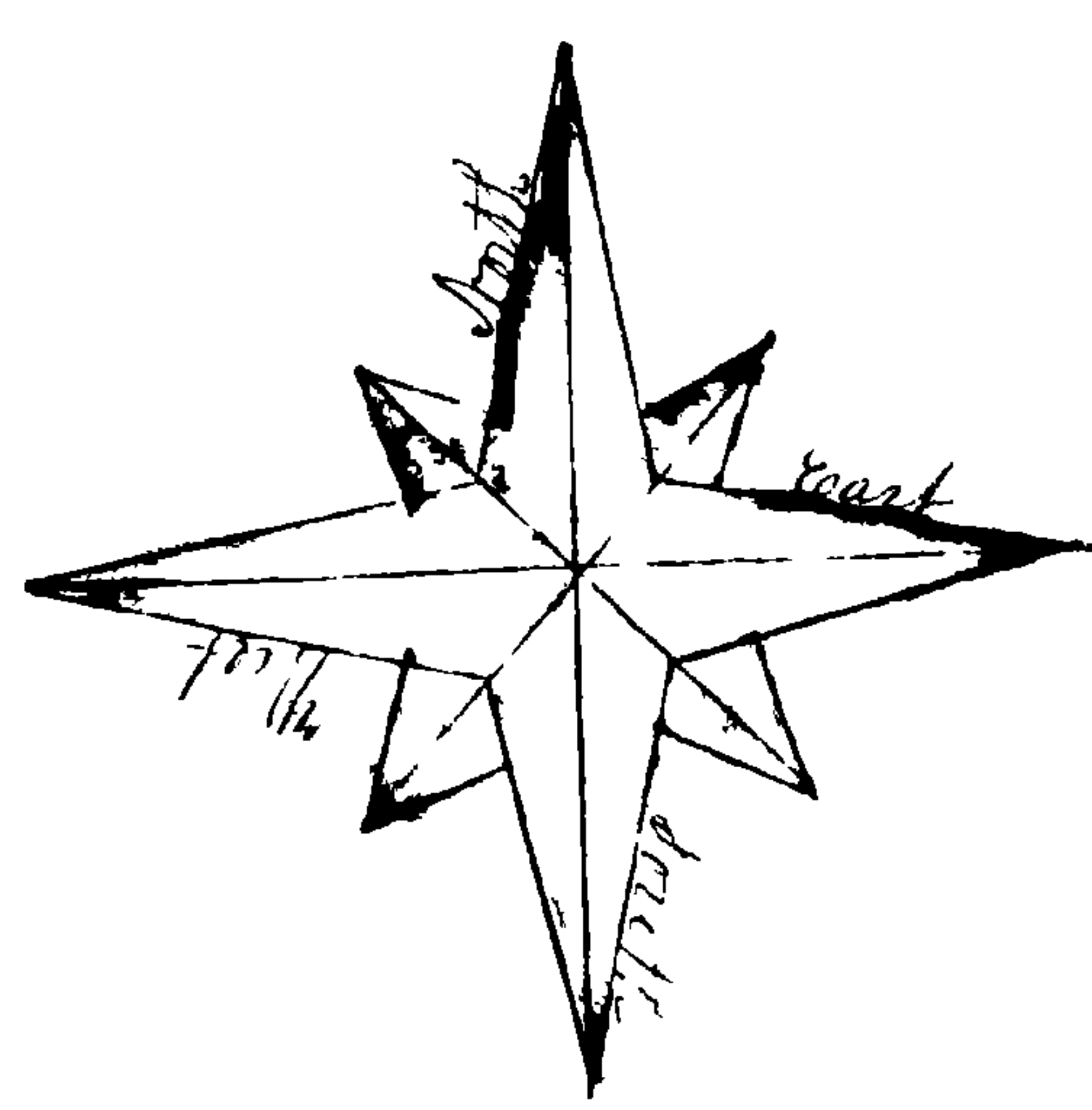
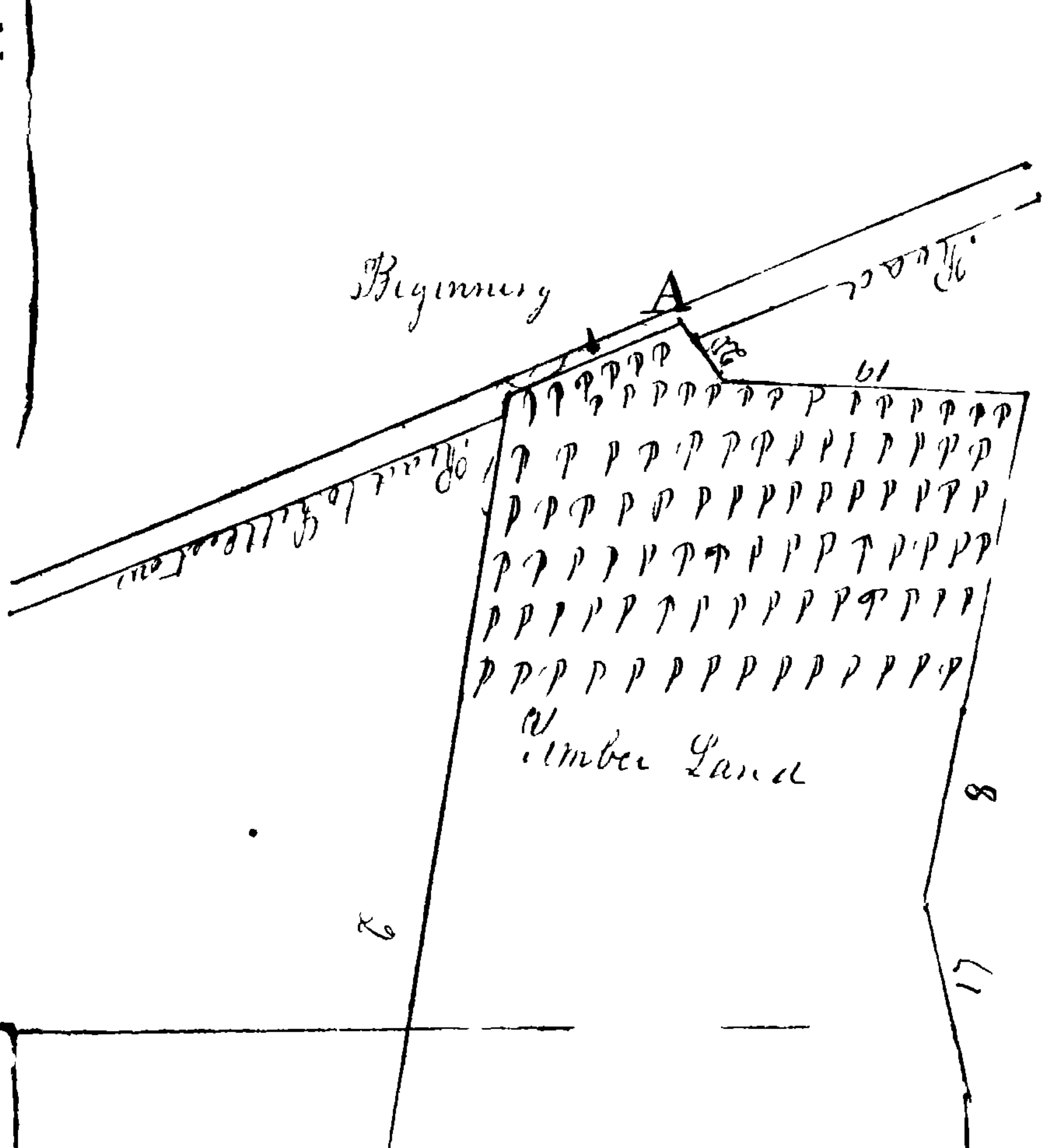


By the Honorable Madison Nelson Circuit Judge for the third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity We hereby certify that in pursuance and in execution of the power vested in us by the annexed Commission and after the taking of the oath which is therein annexed to be taken by us we did go to enter upon and walk over and view the place stated in the said Commission mentioned after notifying the parties interested therein the heirs at law of said Henry Schicknecht dec^d and we do hereby certify that we appointed William Metzger Surveyor to survey said lands and that on the 6th day of Sept^r in the year 1860 the day appointed by us we proceeded to lay off and locate the claim of Susanna A. Schicknecht in the lands and tenements mentioned in the proceedings in the course whereof her late husband Henry Schicknecht died seized and possessed. And we did specify to the said Susanna A. Schicknecht as and for her dower the lands and tenements embraced within the courses and distances unto any boundary depicted in the location and survey made thereof by said W^m Metzger Surveyor under our direction which location and survey is to be taken as part of the return as entered our hands and seals this 11th day of September in the year 1860
