

Courses + distances of Susannah A. Schudknecht's Town in the lands
 of Henry Schudknecht deceased ^{in the farm of said dec^d} known by the name of New Swabia
 being comprised of several original tracts (viz of parts of Williams
 Hook of parts of the Reserve on Kintley Ridge enlarged of part
 of Little Good & part of Quakers Mistake and as the same was
 laid off and located on the 6th day of September 1860 by the Com-
 missioners Daniel Sheffer Geo L Routh and John Harp Wm Metzger &
 Joseph Bonho appointed and commissioned for said purpose
 and as said location of said Susannah A. Schudknecht's town or
 town in the farm of her deceased husband is exhibited on the
 plat found amongst these papers. Beginning for the outlines of said
 town or town at the end of 25 ps by the 17th line of New Swabia
 the same being the 10th line of the tract of land called Williams
 Home and running thence with the outlines of New Swabia allowing
 for variation $S 70^{\circ} W 16$ ps to a stone & $S 8^{\circ} W 96 \frac{1}{2}$ ps to a stone $S 1^{\circ} W 5 \frac{1}{4}$ ps to a stone at the 20th line of the tract of land called
 Quakers Mistake and to the beginning of that part of Quakers
 Mistake and to the beginning of that part of Quakers Mistake
 conveyed to George Routhahn for 133 acres thence with the given line
 thereof crossed $S 47^{\circ} E 16$ ps to a stone at the half line thereof
 then still with the outlines of New Swabia and the first line of
 said 133 acre deed $S 10^{\circ} W 42 \frac{1}{4}$ ps to a stone being a corner
 of the $4 \frac{3}{4}$ acre deed from said Henry Schudknecht deceased to
 George Routhahn and running thence with said deed $S 81^{\circ} E 10$ ps
 to intersect the 12th line of New Swabia at the end of $44 \frac{1}{2}$ ps the
 same being the beginning of the 2^d line of that part of the tract
 of land called Little Good conveyed to said Henry Schudknecht
 deceased by George Routhahn by a deed of conveyance for $7 \frac{1}{4}$ acres
 of land more or less then running with the 2^d line of said $7 \frac{1}{4}$ acre
 deed $S 81^{\circ} E 80$ ps to a stone standing at the beginning of the 16th
 line of the whole tract called New Swabia then with said line
 $S 74^{\circ} E 10$ ps then leaving the outlines of the whole tract of said dec^d
 lands and running through the body of the farm for the division
 lines of said town 12 courses and distances (viz through the
 Orchard $N 26^{\circ} E 19$ ps to a stake in a lane then with said lane
 $N 64^{\circ} W 7$ ps to a stake then through the peach orchard $N 21^{\circ} W 55$ ps
 to a stone fence then with said stone fence $N 61^{\circ} W 18$ ps to a
 worm fence then with 5 courses and distances $N 38^{\circ} E 24$ ps to a
 stake $N 32^{\circ} E 20$ ps to a stake $N 72^{\circ} W 27$ ps to a stake $N 2 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 15$
 ps to a stake $N 13^{\circ} W 17$ ps to a stake $N 19^{\circ} E 45 \frac{1}{2}$ ps through the
 timber land still through the timber land $S 89 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 26$ ps to a
 stake $N 57^{\circ} W 6$ ps to the place of beginning containing 68 acres
 of land more or less.

The courses and distances of Mrs Susannah
 A. Schudknecht's town or town in the Mountain Lot of which
 Henry Schudknecht her husband died seized and possessed
 being a lot of twenty acres + a half an acre more or less of
 land and being a part of a tract of land called Liberty
 is the best policy as it was laid off by the aforesaid Commissioners
