The Cause standing ready for hearing and being submitted to the Court upon the bill answer exhibits & other proceedings which were duly read & considered and it appearing to the Court that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed. It is thereupon this 18th day of May in the year 1861 by me Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity and by the authority of the said Court adjudged ordered and decreed that the sale of the Real Estate specified & described in the bill & Exhibits in this Case made by Augustine Taney & Felix B. Taney as Executors & Trustees under the last will & testament of Joseph Taney Sen Dec^o to said Michael Baldwin be & the same is hereby affirmed ratified & confirmed and it is hereby further ordered adjudged & decreed that Drusus H. Maynard be & he is hereby appointed Trustee in the place of Felix B. Taney the summing Executor & Trustee who declares the execution of said trust to carry out & complete the trust created by the last will & testament of Joseph Taney Sen Dec^o in favor of Joseph Taney and Garnet Taney & their children & heirs at law that said Drusus H. Maynard before he proceeds to act as such Trustee shall file with the Clerk of this Court his bond payable to the State of Maryland in the penal sum of two thousand dollars to be executed by himself with approved security & conditions for the faithful discharge of the trust reposed in him by this decree or order in the premises and it is further adjudged ordered & decreed that the said Drusus H. Maynard as such Trustee shall
