All that piece or parcel of land lying and being in Frederick County, it being part of a part of a tract of land called The Second Resurvey for Sucketts Henry, Midnight resurveyed for William Suckett Oct 30th 1844 for 982 acres. The being a part of that 320 acres part of said Second Resurvey which was surveyed by David Boush on the 28th Sept 1843 and conveyed by Deed to Lloyd Suckett by deed of partition dated the 31st day of July 1857 beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at a stone area (scout post) formerly planted area standing at the end of the first Resurvey being also the end of the first line of Lloyd Suckett's part of the same area running thence with the second line thereof allowing two degrees for variation N 15 1/2 E 57 1/2 perches to a stone now planted at the south end and at the end of the first line of two acres top Row and 12 1/2 perches part of said 320 acres conveyed by the said Charles H & Anna Suckett to Jacob R. Rodenick by deed dated the 21st July 1857 then with the eastern outlines thereof two courses and distances allowing one half degree for variation. 3 N 33 E 20 ps to a stone now planted. 3 N 48 E 63 1/2 ps to a stone now planted at the end of the 7th line of the aforesaid Resurvey being also the end of the 7th line of the aforesaid 320 acres part and with it crossed two courses and distances allowing 2 1/2 degrees for variation 4 N 48 1/2 E 36 ps to a stone formally planted on the west side of the public Road leading to the Catylin Switch on the Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road 5 N 7 1/2 W 33 1/2 ps to a stone formally planted on the West side of said road being at the end of 104 1/2 ps and the 52nd line of the aforesaid Resurvey being also at the end of the third line of 73 A 3 R 16 part of said 320 acres conveyed by Charles H & Anna Suckett to Henry Kopf in or about the year 1845 and with said part crossed two courses and distances allowing 3/4 of a degree for variation 6 S 63 1/2 E 38 1/2 ps to a stone formally planted 7 N 33 E 70 ps to a stone formally planted it being at the end of the 7th line of 64 A 3 R 135 Ps part of said 320 acres conveyed by Charles H & Anna Suckett to William Lakin by deed dated Nov 18th 1850 and with the eighth line thereof allowing 3/4 of a degree for variation 8 S 67 E 106 1/2 ps to a stone formally planted on the 39th line of the aforesaid Resurvey and being also at the end of 62 ps on the 16th line of said 320 acres and with said line crossed allowing 2 1/2 degrees for variation 9 S 13 1/4 W 63 ps to the beginning thereof still with the outlines of said 320 acres crossed allowing said 2 1/2 degrees for variation three courses and distances 10 S 80 1/2 E 148 ps
