The object of the Bill filed in this case is to obtain a decree for the sale of the real estate of which Henry Hornsperger late of Frederick County deceased died seized. The bill states in substance that on or about the 11th day of January 1859 the said Henry Hornsperger died seized of two farms or parcels of land lying in Frederick County the one containing 9 1/2 acres more or less & the other containing 177 acres more or less & that he left the complainant William S.
