Hensperger died some six years ago Elizabeth Barnett left three children to wit. Charles C. Ada Florence and Susan M. all of whom are infants and reside in Frederick County. Oliver H. Hensperger left two children Seth and Clay both of whom are infants and reside in Frederick County. In the 5th Interrogatory I am the widow of Henry Hensperger and am now sixty three years of age. In the 6th Interrogatory Henry Hensperger died seized of two farms the one containing one hundred and seventy seven acres of land the other about 9 1/2 acres they are both located in Frederick County. In the 7th Interrogatory I desire my diverse interests in said lands to be left off. I do not think that the said lands can be advantageously divided between all the heirs at law interested therein and entitled thereto but I do think it would be to their interest and benefit to have said lands sold and the monies accruing therefrom distributed among the parties entitled thereto my reason therefor is that there is not a sufficient quantity of land to be advantageously divided among so many heirs and as for the infants interested I think it would be much to their advantage to have the money. In the 8th Interrogatory I know nothing further also at the same time and place John Dargy a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainants being duly sworn and examined by the Interrogatories filed with me by the Solicitor for the Complainants and presently returned deposes to the effect Interrogatory. I know all the parties to this suit except the infant children in the State of Texas and have known them since their birth. In the 2nd Interrogatory I know Henry Hensperger he died intestate about two years ago. In the 3rd Interrogatory Henry Hensperger left the following children to wit William S. Hensperger Harriet Williard widow of Abraham Williard Elizabeth S. Barnett the wife of Levi Barnett since deceased Aaron B. Hensperger and Amanda H. Hensperger all of whom reside in Frederick County and Henry C. Hensperger who resides in the State of Kentucky Selphman J. Hensperger who resides in the State of California Mary C. the wife of George Frode who resides in the State of Indiana Melinda S. the wife of James Smith who resides in the State of Kentucky Sarah C. the wife of William Wallace who resides in the State of Texas at the time of his death and Oliver H. Hensperger who died before his Father and who resided in the State of Texas at the time of his death. In the 4th Interrogatory Henry Hensperger deceased left a widow who is still living and is the preceding witness she is about 63 years of age. In the 6th Interrogatory He died seized of two farms the one contains about 9 1/2 acres
