The bill of Complaint of Peter Her Mary Her Barbara Feitz &

& possessed of a tract of land called The Reserve on Good Neigh
borhood containing about forty seven acres of land more or less
situate in the County of Frederick & State of Maryland being
the same devised to said Jacob Her by his father Conrad Her
his last will and testament as will appear by a true and
Certified Extract thereof hereunto filed as Exhibit N^o 1 which
with all other Exhibits your orators pray may be taken as a
part of this their bill of Complaint as if here inserted
in words & figures that said Jacob Her died intestate
about the year 1859 seized and possessed of said Real
estate which is particularly described in the deed thereof
from Balen Fox to Conrad Her and in the plot and
Courses & distances of Survey which with a true and Certified
Copy of said deed are hereunto filed marked respectively
Exhibit N^o 2 & Exhibit N^o 3 your orators further state that
they said Jacob Her died leaving the following as his only children
& heirs at law viz Conrad Her Peter Her Mary Her
Barbara Her with your orators Sarah Feitz John
Her and William Her all of whom are adults over the age
of 21 years your orators further state that the said Jacob Her
by in the year 1852 petitioned for the benefit of the insolvent
