

there being no vacancy adjoining the same I have corrected  
 the outlines thereof agreeable to the adjoining holdings and  
 by No 3 the original called &c. thereof. Beginning for the same at  
 a stone formally planted at the end of 33 ps on the 4th  
 line of part of said Resurvey called The Resurvey on Good  
 Neighbourhood it also being the end of the 9th line of a  
 tract of land called Foxes Safe Guard granted Bathyr  
 Fox and others on the 19th day of June 1812 for 167 acres -  
 and also it being the end of the 5th line of a tract  
 of land called Fatt Mutton enlarged Resurveyed for  
 Henry Fox the 5th day of February 1802 and granted him  
 on the 12th day of September 1812 for 23 1/2 acres and running  
 thence with said line across Co Wit N 77 1/2 degrees East -  
 143 3/4 ps to a stone formally planted and standing at the  
 end of the 4th line of said land called Fatt Mutton  
 enlarged it also being on the 14th line of the aforesaid  
 original called The Resurvey on Good Neighbourhood they  
 with said line across North 62 3/4 degrees to a stone form-  
 ally planted and standing at the end of the 13th line  
 of said original it also being one of the corners of -  
 Bathyr Fox land called Arnolds Integrity then still  
 North 18 1/2 ps to a stone formally planted and standing  
 at the end of the 2d line of said Foxes Lot it being part of  
 the aforesaid land called Arnolds Integrity then bounding  
 on and with said lot the 4 following Courses and distances  
 viz South 35 1/4 degrees West 15 ps to a stone South 86 1/4  
 degrees West 11 ps to a stone North 18 1/4 degrees West 24 ps  
 to a stone South 71 degrees West 6 1/2 ps to a stone formally  
 planted and standing at the Beginning of that part of  
 a tract of land called Addition to Arnolds Integrity  
 as was on the 19th day of January 1811 conveyed by  
 Captain Arnold Hardy to Noah Phillips for 2 1/2 Acres + 37  
 ps of land then with said deed the 2 following -  
 Courses + distances South 71 degrees West 30 1/2 ps to a stone  
 planted still North 18 1/4 degrees West 143 ps to a stone planted  
 at the end of the 13th line of the aforesaid land called  
 Foxes Safe Guard then with the outline thereof across  
 4 Courses and distances viz South 35 1/2 degrees West 17 ps  
 to a marked Black Oak tree South 2 1/2 degrees East 58 ps  
 to a stone planted formally South 83 1/4 degrees East 42 ps  
 to a stone non planted then South 24 degrees East 146 1/2 ps  
 to the spot mentioned beginning and containing 47 1/4  
 acres Resurveyed this 8th day of May 1833 &c. &c. &c. Delight
