 the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas  
 on application of said Jacob Her of Frederick County  
 Insolvency Law of 1865 and the several supplements  
 thereto the said John M. Harlan was at the time of said  
 application appointed trustee for and in behalf of the  
 creditors of the said Jacob Her of Frederick County  
 Witnesseth that the said Jacob Her of Frederick County  
 in consideration of the several hundred dollars  
 paid in hand by the said John M. Harlan the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted sold  
 bargained assigned and set over and by these presents  
 doth absolutely grant bargain sell transfer and set over  
 to the said John M. Harlan and his assigns all the  
 property real and personal of every nature & quality  
 excepting the necessary wearing apparel and bedding  
 of himself and family which the said Jacob Her has a claim  
 title to or interest in at the date of these presents to have  
 and to hold the same unto him the said John M. Harlan  
 and his assigns in trust to and for the creditors of the  
 said Jacob Her of Frederick County and for their benefit agreeable to
