

instituted suit against the said Peregrine Fitzhugh and your
 petitioning in the Circuit Court for Bryan County of Georgia
 and that Judgment was obtained thereon at the February
 term 1857 of said Court in N^o 138 on the trial docket of
 said Court for the sum of fifteen hundred and fifteen
 dollars with interest thereon from the 13th of September 1856
 until paid and cost of suit which case is N^o 49 on the
 judicial docket of said Court to October term 1858 - and that
 the said note was one of the notes referred to in said mortgage
 of the 9th of October 1856 and for which she was indemnified
 in and by said mortgage as aforesaid and that on the
 5th day of November A. D. 1858 your petitioner paid to
 Francis Schelberger Esq attorney for said mortgage the sum
 of six hundred and forty five dollars and ninety four
 cents being the balance in full then due on said judgment
 the residue having been previously made by the Sheriff of said
 County by an execution on said judgment issued and
 that she took an assignment of said judgment or so much
 thereof as she paid as aforesaid according to the act of
 Assembly in such case made and provided, all of which
 will more fully and at large appear by reference to a duly
 authenticated copy of said note judgment assignment & both
 the affidavit of your petitioner thereto annexed herewith
 filed marked Exhibit of N^o 14 and your petitioning
 copies and charges that the whole of said sum of six
 hundred and forty five dollars and ninety four cents with
 interest from the 5th day of November 1858 remains unpaid
 and now due and owing to her and that she is entitled
 to have the same allowed and paid to her out of the proceeds
 of the sale of the property embraced in said mortgage of the
 9th of October 1856 (and which is the same that was sold
 by the trustees in this case as will appear by reference to the
 said mortgage and their said report of sales) at least to the
 extent of the amount of said property owned by the said
 Peregrine Fitzhugh & your petitioner also charge that she
 was together with the said Lopez and captain William S.
 McPherson security for the said Peregrine Fitzhugh in a joint
 and several promissory note dated at the 25th of January 1853
 at Station Roman Frederick's County for the sum of one thousand
 and sixty one dollars and ninety seven cents (\$1061.97) for
 value received payable to William Callaghan or order with
 interest from date thirty days after date thereof and that suit
 was instituted on the 14th of the said Callaghan's judgment
 rendered thereon at the February term 1858 for the sum of one thousand
 and sixty one dollars and ninety seven cents with interest from
 the 25th of January 1853 until paid and cost of suit against
 the said Peregrine Fitzhugh Lopez Fitzhugh William S. McPherson
 and your petitioner that said note is one of the notes referred
