 and I received the money from Augustus Stone one of executors
 of Denton Hammond - The receipts on Exhibits marked as Exhibits
 N^o 1, 2, & 3 are all in the handwriting of Thomas Sappington said
 Sappington is dead. May at the same time and place Jas. D.
 Williams a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the
 Complainants being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories
 filed with me by the Solicitor for the Complainants and herewith
 returned deposes and says, On the first 2, 3 & 4 Interrogatories
 raised as to this witness. On the 5th Interrogatory the papers
 now shown me marked and filed in this Cause as Exhibits
 marked N^o 36 & 37 are notes executed by Denton Hammond to Allen B.
 Hammond and by Allen Hammond indorsed said notes came from the
 Frederick County Bank from the Washington County Bank on the 3^d
 September 1837 \$320 was paid on said notes by Denton Hammond
 by John Kinzer and was received in the Bank by A. C. Myers.
 Then a teller in said Bank the 2^d credit on note marked and
 filed as exhibit N^o 36 was received on the 5th of August 1837 -
 amounting to \$578⁸⁷ from Augustus Stone one of the executors
 of Denton Hammond. The first receipt on note N^o 36 was signed
 by A. C. Myers then a teller in the Frederick County Bank the 2^d
 was signed by myself a Cashier of said Bank on note filed
 in this Cause as exhibit N^o 37 the whole amount of \$910.56 was
 paid me by Augustus Stone executor of Denton Hammond and
 I accepted accordingly. On the 6th & last raised as to the witness.
 By request of the Solicitor for Complainants this Commission was
 adjourned over until Saturday the 3^d day of August at which time
 and at the place aforesaid. I did proceed to take further depo-
 sitions to wit, Jacob Oberly a witness of lawful age produced
 on the part of the Complainants being duly sworn and examined
 to interrogatories filed with me by the Solicitor for Complainants
 and herewith returned deposes and says, The 1st 2^d 3^d & 4th Interroga-
 tories by request of the Solicitor for Complainants are raised as to
 this witness. On the 5th Interrogatory The signature to exhibit
 marked N^o 34 is in the handwriting of Denton Hammond the signature
 to the receipt indorsed on said exhibit is in my handwriting and
 I received the money from Augustus Stone executor of Denton
