N^o 15 Exhibit filed in this Cause is in the handwriting of C. N. Barber I know that at the time that receipt was given which is endorsed on Exhibit N^o 15, C. N. Barber and W. Barber were in business together and that the receipt as I have stated & believe to be in the handwriting of C. N. Barber one of the partners of said firm. The remaining Interrogatories are raised as to this matter. Also at the same time and place James Mc Dermott a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainants being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with me by the Solicitor for Complainants and herewith returned deposes and says. The 1st 2^d 3^d & 4th Interrogatories raised as to this matter. To the 5th Interrogatory I look at the now shown one marked Exhibit N^o 24 is a receipt given by one as agent of John Mc Dermott to Augustus Stoner Executor of Denton Hammond and receiving the money for the paper from said Stoner I am the son of John Mc Dermott and the receipt is in my hand writing. At the request of the complainants I adjourned this Commission over until August the 5th 1861 at which time and at the place aforesaid Howard Hoagwood a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainants being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with me by the Solicitor for Complainants and herewith returned deposes and says. The signature to the receipt attached to exhibit N^o 30 is mine & I signed said receipt received the money from Augustus Stoner Executor as aforesaid. Remaining Interrogatories raised as to this matter.
