This Cause standing ready for hearing and being submitted the proceedings were read & considered & it thereupon this first day of October in the year 1861 by the Hon. Madison Nelson Circuit Judge for the third Judicial District of the State of Maryland and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity adjudged ordered and decreed that the real estate in the proceedings mentioned or so much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of the debts of Danton Campson be sold & that John Kinzer of Frederick County be and he is hereby appointed trustee to make such sale and that that the time and manner of his proceeding shall be as follows. He shall first file in the Clerk's office a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by himself with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of eight thousand dollars Conditioning for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him by this decree or which may be reposed in him by any future order or decree in the premises. He shall then proceed to make sale of the said real estate having first given at least three weeks previous notice written in some newspaper printed in Frederick and such other notice as he may think proper of the time place manner and terms of sale which terms shall be as follows one third Cash to be paid on the day of sale a ratification thereof by the Court the residue in two equal annual payments the purchaser or purchasers giving his or their notes with approved security bearing date from the day of sale with interest from date.

And as soon as may be conveniently after any such sale or sales the said trustee shall return to this Court a full and particular account of the same with an affidavit of the truth thereof and of the fairness of such sale or sales announced and as
