 and giving notice of the time place manner and terms
 of sale by advertisement in the Banner of Liberty a newspaper
 printed in Frederick County for more than three successive
 weeks before the day of sale and by handbills extensively circu-
 lated in Frederick County he did pursuant to said notice

 Frederick County on Saturday the 9th day of November in the

 sale to the highest bidder the farm situate in Frederick County
 State of Maryland being part of a tract of land called
 "The Recovery on Spring Garden" containing eighty one acres
 and seven eighths of an acre and described in Exhibit No 3 -
 in this bill and sold the same to Augustus Stone at and
 for the sum of sixty dollars per acre making an aggregate
 sum of four thousand nine hundred and fifty dollars
 and fifty cents upon the terms presented by the decree and
 I further report that the said Augustus Stone having large
 claims against the estate and being also tenant by the
 entirety has not yet complied with the terms of sale but
 is willing to do so at any time when his claims shall be
 ascertained - All of which is respectfully submitted.
