At the request of John Ogle the following
Deed is recorded April 10th 1821 by -
This Indenture made the fifth day of April in the year of
Our Lord 1821 between Nicholas Randall Executor of the last
will and testament of Nicholas Randall of Frederick County in
the State of Maryland deceased of the one part and John Ogle
of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas
Nicholas Randall deceased by his last will and testament
bearing date the 28th day of July 1819 and recorded in Liber N. B.
N. 2 one of the record Books of Wills in the office of the Register
of Wills of Frederick County did authorize and empower his
Executor to sell and dispose of all his property real personal
& mixed not specifically devised and bequeathed for the
purpose expressed in his will and did constitute and
appoint his son Nicholas Randall and Joseph Lauston
his Executors to carry the same into execution and the said
Joseph Lauston did by writing acknowledge and record
in the office of Register of Wills aforesaid a return and
decline acting as Executor of said Will and letters testamen-
tary have been since granted by the Orphans Court of said
County to said Nicholas Randall alone and as sole
Executor thereof and in pursuance of the authority under
said will the said Nicholas Randall has sold a part
of the real estate of said Nicholas Randall deceased to
John Ogle the grantee herein. This Indenture Witnesseth
that the said Nicholas Randall Executor as aforesaid for
and in consideration of the sum of eight thousand seven
hundred and seventy three dollars and eight cents
quarters cents current money to him in hand paid before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged both granted bargain and sold
alike of release release and confirm and by these pre-
sents the said Nicholas Randall doth grant bargain
and sell alike release release and confirm unto the said
John Ogle and his heirs all that part of a tract of land
called Monocacy Swamp being part of a parcel of land
conveyed by William Campbell to Nicholas Randall for four
hundred and eighty four acres one quarter and twenty four
square perches of land by deed dated the 11th day of April
1814 Beginning for the part or parcel hereby intended to be
conveyed at a stone planted on the bank of Monocacy River
