Ogle Jane E. Ogle and Anna S. Ogle his sole heirs at law and whereas the said John Oliver Ogle has sold his right title and estate in and to said land being one fourth part to the said Catharine M. Ogle Jane E. Ogle and Anna S. Ogle. Now this and Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of twenty six hundred and fifty dollars the said John Oliver Ogle and Matilda A. Ogle his wife do release and grant in fee simple to the said Catharine M. Ogle Jane E. Ogle and Anna S. Ogle all the right title and estate at law and in equity being one undivided
