Be it enacted by the State of Maryland that Lane E. Ogle & Ann E. Ogle of Frederick County be and they are hereby commanded that they procure set apart good persons to appear before the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity to be held at the Court house in Frederick town in and for Lida County on the first Monday of July next to answer the bill and Complaint of Catharine M. Ogle against you in an said Court rightfull and so forth, Wholly fail and not as you ever answer the contrary at your peril of Pitance the Journal Madam Nelson Judge of our said Court the 11th day of February 1861, if you do the 23^d day of March 1861
