 1860 and passed in Cause No 2937 on the Equity docket
 of said Court the above signed John W. Barnick has been
 appointed Trustee to sell the real estate therein mentioned
 Nor the Creditors of the above obligation is such that if the
 above named John W. Barnick shall well and faithfully
 execute the trust upon him by said decree or which may
 be imposed upon him by any further decree or order in these
 premises then the above obligation to be void and none
 effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law
