Therefore I command you that at such certain day and place as you shall think fit you go to the said defendants if they cannot conveniently come to you and assign and appoint a guardian for the aforesaid infants and take the answer of the said infants by such guardian to the Bill of Complaint on such guardian's Coram oath upon the Holy Evangelists to be administered by you the said answer being distinctly and plainly written. And when you shall have so taken the said answer you are to send the same closed up under your seal together with your Certificate of your having assigned and appointed such guardian as aforesaid and then put into me in said Court.
